Red Lobster's Luscious Cheese-Garlic Biscuits

2 1/2 cups Bisquick baking mix
 3/4 cup cold whole milk
 4 T. cold butter (1/2 stick)
 1/4 tsp. garlic powder
 1 heaping cup grated cheddar cheese

Brush on Top:
 2 T. butter, melted
 1/4 tsp. dried parsley flakes
 1/2 tsp. garlic powder
 Pinch salt

Directions: Preheat oven to 400 degrees.
 Combine Bisquick with cold butter in medium bowl using a pastry cutter or large fork. Not too thoroughly. It will have small chunks of butter but that is O K. Add cheddar cheese, milk and 1/4 tsp. garlic. Mix by hand (don't over mix)

Drop approx. 1/4 cup portions of dough on un-greased cookie sheet using ice cream scoop.

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Bake 15 to 17 min. or until tops of biscuits turn light brown. When you take biscuits out of oven, melt 2 T. butter in a small bowl in your microwave. Stir in 1/2 tsp. garlic powder and the dried parsley flakes. Use a brush to spread over the tops of all biscuits.
