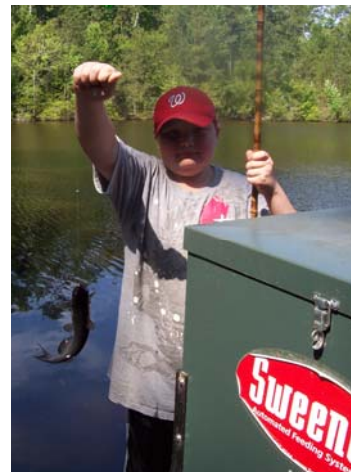
Day in the Country
